



Another victory in our lawsuit about unhoused people's belongings

In April, a federal judge blocked the City of LA from taking and also destroying homeless people's items based on size. This week, the same judge found the City in contempt for placing signs in and around encampments that misled people into believing that their "bulky items" are still prohibited and the City could still take them.

Under LAMC 56.11, the City defines bulky items as "any item, with the exception of a constructed tent, operational bicycle or operational walker, crutch or wheelchair, that is too large to fit into a 60-gallon container with the lid closed," and authorized City workers to take these items from people and throw them away.^[SM1] This, however, resulted in many people's important belongings being thrown out. Seven unhoused plaintiffs and Ktown for All sued the City to stop it from taking unhoused people's belongings and as part of that lawsuit, asked the Court to block the "bulky item" part of the law from being enforced.

The judge ordered the City to stop enforcing this part of the law and also not to post notices that bulky items are prohibited around encampments, but even that didn't stop the City from posting these notices. ^[SM2] We filed a motion to hold the City in contempt for violating this order. The City Attorney tried to argue that the City substantially complied with the order, but the judge ruled in our favor, saying that full compliance was required.

We at Ktown for All are committed to ensuring that City policies do not criminalize homelessness and violate the rights of our unhoused members and neighbors. If you see any notices or hear anything from City officials that violate this order, let us know.

Homeless Shelter Under Construction at Lafayette Park

The City of LA is building a homeless shelter at Lafayette Park (Hoover/Wilshire). Homeless service provider, PATH, is identifying potential clients for the shelter. At this time, PATH is asking us (Ktown for All) for help in finding people who might be interested in entering the shelter. To be clear, we are not professional service providers. Ktown for All consists entirely of unpaid volunteers, but we have offered to assist PATH in identifying interested people.

Additional information about the shelter:

- This is a 24/7 shelter - you do not have to leave during the day
- Both men and women are allowed
- There will be floor-to-ceiling partitions between beds for privacy
- There will be a total of 72 beds

PATH needs your first and last name to determine your eligibility. Any contact info would be helpful too. Ideally, they would like your location to make an in-person visit, but if you're uncomfortable with that, PATH can meet you elsewhere.

Se está construyendo un refugio para personas sin hogar en el parque Lafayette

La ciudad de Los Ángeles está construyendo un refugio para personas sin hogar en el parque Lafayette (en la esquina de Hoover y Wilshire). PATH, un organismo que provee servicios a las personas sin hogar, está identificando clientes potenciales para el refugio. PATH ha pedido nuestra ayuda (como voluntarios de Ktown for All [Ktown para todos]) para encontrar personas interesadas en la posibilidad de vivir en el refugio. Para ser claros, Ktown for All no es proveedor de servicios profesionales. Ktown for All consiste enteramente en voluntarios no remunerados, pero nos hemos ofrecido a ayudar a PATH a identificar a las personas sin hogar interesadas. Simplemente queremos que nuestros vecinos estén al corriente de esta información.










Más sobre el refugio:

- El refugio estará abierto 24 horas, todos los días - no hay que salir durante el día
- Tanto hombres como mujeres están permitidos
- Habrá divisiones de suelo a techo entre las camas para la privacidad
- Habrá un total 72 camas

El organismo PATH necesita su nombre y apellido para determinar su elegibilidad. Cualquier información de contacto, por ejemplo, número de teléfono o correo electrónico, también sería útil.
