



VICTORY! CRIMINALIZATION ORDINANCE DEFEATED

On Oct. 28, LA City Council attempted to pass an ordinance that would make it illegal to sit, sleep, lie down, and store property in public spaces throughout LA. Ktown for All and our coalition partners succeeded in organizing to delay the vote on this motion. In response to public outrage, a majority of City Council backed away from the motion. Council President Nury Martinez was furious that she failed to obtain enough votes to pass the ordinance and announced that the vote would be held on Nov. 24th.

In the weeks and days leading up to the big vote on Nov. 24th, advocacy organizations, homeless service providers, and activists mobilized like never before to influence votes ahead of Nov. 24th. The Services Not Sweeps coalition protested in front of Councilman Joe Buscaino's house in San Pedro, we had countless meetings with council offices, we held blanket and clothing drives in front of council members' offices who were in support of criminalization, and on Friday, we held a "Twitter storm" that propelled the hashtag #HousekeysNotHandcuffs to #1 trending term on Twitter in the LA area. On Friday afternoon, Council President Nury Martinez announced that there will be no vote on the proposed ordinance.

With this victory, we hope that LA City Council will look to implementing real solutions to homelessness that does not involve criminalizing the act of being homeless. For now, unhoused Angelenos will not face the prospect of a citation or arrest for sitting, sleeping, and lying down on the sidewalk.










Covid-19 Surge in Los Angeles County

Covid-19 is surging across the country and in Los Angeles. On Thursday November 19th, Los Angeles County hit a new record high of 5,031 in new Covid-19 positive cases. This brings the total number of positive cases reported in Los Angeles County to 353,232 with 7,363 deaths. Due to the surge in cases, California Governor Gavin Newsom ordered a limited stay at home order. **Starting Sunday, work, movement, and gatherings between 10pm and 5am are prohibited.** Essential work and movement is exempt from the order.

To protect yourself and help prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- Wash your hands or sanitize frequently
- Avoid touching your face
- Avoid sharing food & drink
- Wear a face covering or mask when around others
- Stay at least 6 feet away from other people
- Keep interactions short
- Avoid surfaces touched by others
