



SWEEP REFORM ON THE HORIZON?

LA City Council is considering a motion to reform CARE/CARE+ encampment sweeps. Under current policy, and against CDC pandemic guidelines, CARE and CARE+ sweeps have forced unhoused people to immediately move themselves, their shelters, and their belongings out of the sweep area, or to risk having them confiscated & thrown out by LA Sanitation. The new motion introduced on January 13th by Council members Mike Bonin (Council District 11, West LA and Venice) and Nithya Raman (CD 4, which includes part of Koreatown) proposes to put an end to coercive displacement, and focus instead on providing voluntary trash pickup and cleaning services that will comply with federal health and safety guidelines. Council member Kevin de Leon (CD14, Boyle Heights and Downtown) seconded the motion.

- If this motion passes, new protocols will include:**
- Regular, scheduled and well-publicized cleanings
 - Voluntary trash and bulky item pickup
 - Designated areas for trash and waste removal
 - Mobile showers & bathrooms

- Provision of shade structures where people can temporarily deposit items during cleaning
- COVID-testing
- tent exchange and distribution
- food and water
- Outreach and facilitation conducted by community partners and ambassadors
- Hiring of unhoused persons to keep areas tidy between LASAN cleanings
- Reasonable accommodation for people with disabilities
- No use of law enforcement personnel

Ktown for All believes that this motion will make for a more humane and effective city response to the needs of people experiencing homelessness, and ensure people’s safety especially as the COVID-19 pandemic continues. We will keep you updated on the motion as it moves through City Council.

COVID-19 SURGE REMAINS CRITICAL
