



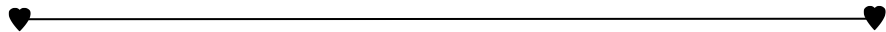

URGENT PUSH TO EXPAND HOUSING PROGRAMS

Due to the public health emergency posed by COVID-19, the federal government is providing money for cities to aggressively expand homeless housing programs through FEMA, the Federal Emergency Management Agency. On Thursday, February 11, LA City Council's Homelessness & Poverty Committee voted for a motion to use this FEMA money to acquire or lease hotels and motels and convert them to housing for unsheltered people. The motion will have to go through the full council, but it is expected to pass. While this will take time to scale up, we hope to see more hotels and motels in the city of LA converted to housing soon.

The Homelessness & Poverty Committee also voted for a modification of the Safe Parking program, which provides people sheltering in their cars a safe place to park combined with service access. At last count there were only about 500 spots for the 18k Angelenos sheltering in their cars. The new motion removes barriers for the city to create more of these programs on city-owned lots.

Committee member Kevin de Leon put forward a motion for the city of LA to purchase the vacant CalTrans-owned properties in El Sereno, restore them to habitable condition, and house people in them immediately. Over Thanksgiving weekend, these properties were reclaimed by unhoused families only briefly before CalTrans evicted and arrested them. This motion passed the committee and will be brought before City Council for a final vote.



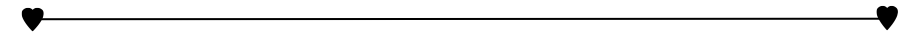
FREE DENTAL CLINIC





